Founded in 2001, English for New Bostonians (ENB) is a Boston-based nonprofit that works to increase opportunities for immigrants to learn English and pursue their educational, economic and civic aspirations. ENB supports 23 high quality English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) programs that provide free or low-cost instruction to immigrant parents, workers, and small business owners. We drive innovation in the field, train instructors and provide professional development opportunities in classroom technology and other best practices. ENB also leads the statewide English Works Campaign, promoting ESOL investment as an imperative to a strong workforce.

Through the pandemic, ENB has been the backbone of Boston's ESOL system, and has provided leadership to make English language training a part of a universal economic and educational equity agenda.


